

This Gospel (John 4) is often proclaimed on the Third Sunday of Lent. In this program we will hear the Samaritan Woman's story in her own words through the art of dramatic interpretation. Praying with images of thirst, we will draw closer to the "living water" that Jesus offers us all.

**Broken Body of Christ/Broken Body of Earth: A Call to Ecological Conversion**

Using the insights of Pope Francis' letter *Laudato Si*, Ecological Spirituality/Theology, and the New Cosmology as well as her own personal experiences of living on the land, Sr. Margaret will explore how "living our vocation to be protectors of God's handiwork is essential to a life of virtue, not an optional or secondary aspect of our Christian experience."
